Gone Fishing for Old Florida: Voices of Cortez

Welcome to the oldest surviving fishing village in the state, dating back to the 1880s. With tropical breezes, fresh fish, and laid-back locals this is truly a place out of another time. Fresh mullet, grouper and stone crab are caught here daily by local fishermen who still make a living by casting their lines and nets into these blue green waters. Meet some real life fisherman of several generations---"Red Dog," "Blue," and "Soupy"--- and discover the secrets to this waterside village that has its own special rhythms. The Swamp

PROTECTING PARADISE

The Western Everglades

For more than a century, dreamers and schemers have tried to drain and claim the Florida Everglades. In Southwest Florida, on the western edge of the Everglades, plume hunting, clear-cutting of ancient cypress trees, development of the "world's largest subdivision" and the "world's largest supersonic jetport" near Everglades National Park, inspired a groundswell of grassroots effort to protect the vanishing wet wilderness known as the Western Everglades. Narrated by Peter Thomas (Nova), this program tells the story through historic photographs, vintage footage and interviews with leaders of the early conservation movement and biologists and environmentalists. 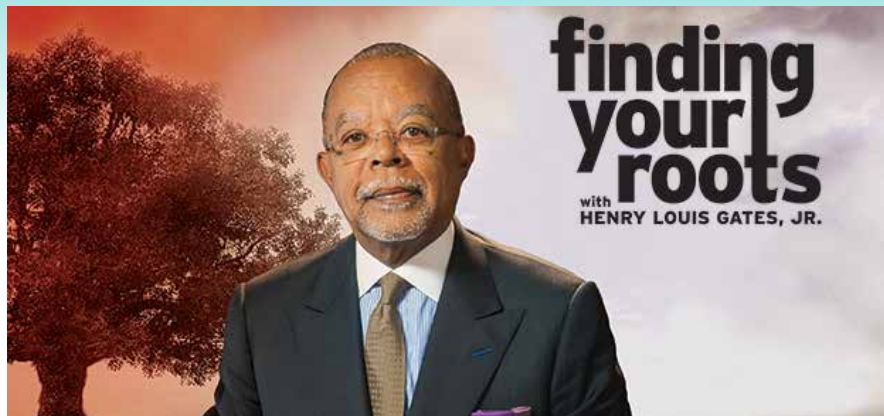

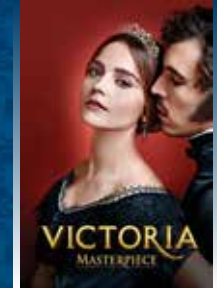
