Community Outreach:

Increasing community health through community outreach



Outreach Free Clinic and Resource Center volunteers and staff recently spent a Saturday morning at a community outreach event hosted by Bread of Refuge. A number of community service organizations were available during the event to assist local homeless and low-income families connect with services that are available to them.

The clinic team provided blood pressure checks and gave out blood pressure journals. They also answered health questions, assisted attendees with registering as a patient with the clinic, or helped with the application process for Hillsborough County Health Care depending on the program they in which they qualified.

At the end of the day, the clinic provided blood pressure checks for more than 30 attendees. The team also screened and registered 8 new clinic patients and connected with more than 20 other community service groups for future collaborations.

A letter from the **Executive Director...**

Dear Friends of Outreach Free Clinic and Resource Center.

Take a moment to really think about the last time you were in pain. Did you wake up in the morning and step out of bed to only



be met with a throbbing pain somewhere? What did you do? Did you take a few aspirin and just carry on with your day? You might have thought, "I probably just slept on it wrong" or "maybe I did too much yard work yesterday." After a few days of trying to nurse it yourself, what did you do when the pain didn't go away? How did you manage your day? Were you exhausted, frustrated, irritable? How

long did you just deal with it before calling your doctor?

For people without medical coverage like the patients of Outreach Free Clinic and Resource Center, the answers to these questions will be very different from yours and mine.

A patient that came into the clinic recently was exhibiting difficulty walking. Without insurance or out-of-pocket funds to visit a doctor, he had been finding ways to cope with the pain for many months, if not years. He had finally reached the end of his rope when he finally found the clinic.

He was highly billigerant with the front desk when he arrived for his appointment. He continued to be volatile with his volunteer doctor, repeatedly shouting, calling names, and refusing to answer standard questions about his condition. Anywhere else, this type of behavior would likely get a patient immediately discharged and escorted out of the building at the very least.

But instead, what happened next is what makes Outreach Clinic and Resource Center truly special! The clinic team, despite his continued insults, spent more than an hour reassuring and counseling the patient until he was at ease and began to cooperate and respond to questions. By the end of the appointment, the doctor was giving him his personal cell number so the patient could call later that evening to update us on how he was feeling. You would have thought that they were long-time friends. Ultimately, the chronic pain that the patient had been suffering signaled the need for a hip replacement and other care. Now, take a moment to really think about how you would have managed that type of chronic pain, for that long, with nowhere else to turn?

Thanks to the generous support from volunteers, donors, and community partners, the clinic team will be able to provide the patient the care and relief that he has needed for a very long time.

Outreach Free Clinic and Resource Center has earned a 2021 Silver Rating from the National Association of

Free and Charitable Clinics (NAFC) Quality Standards Program. To quantify and qualify the care provided at the Free and Charitable Clinic network, the NAFC formalized a set

Apply Sunscreen

Skin cancer is the most preventable type of cancer in the U.S., still more than 5 million people are being diagnosed annually. Therefore it is important to apply sunscreen everyday on the exposed areas of your skin.

Wear Protective Clothing

Protective clothing protects you from from the sun's rays and UV exposure. Waring a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses helps protect delicate skin around your eyes, neck, and face when you outdoors.

Be Aware of Medications

Many medications can make your skin more sensitive to sun exposure. Check with your doctor or pharmacist regarding your current medications and sun exposure. Limit your sun exposure while taking medications like antibiotics, antifungals, or acne.

Seek Shade, Avoid Tanning Beds

Avoid exessive sun exposure between 10 - 4pm when sun intesity is at its highest. Don't fall for the myth that tanning beds are safer! Due to the prolonged and intense exposure, tanning beds can be more dangerous.

Conduct Regular Screenings

Be aware of any new marks, blemishes, or changes in your skin. If you have a concern, see your medical provider to ensure early detection to catch skin cancer in its early stage!
